

First Person Plural Membership Application / Renewal 2011-2012

There are three categories of membership as follows:

- **FULL membership** is open ONLY to individual adult survivors of childhood abuse & trauma who experience (or have recovered from) the most complex types of dissociative distress (e.g. multiple personalities / dissociative identities / Dissociative Disorder Not Otherwise Specified) and who are resident in the UK
- **ASSOCIATE membership** is open to other adults resident or based in the UK who have an interest in complex dissociative distress e.g. friends, partners or relatives of an individual who lives with (or has recovered from) complex dissociative distress; other adult survivors of childhood abuse; mental health service users; individual therapists/counsellors, health or social care professionals and allied workers; related organisations.
- **INTERNATIONAL membership** is open to any individual or organisation who would otherwise meet the criteria for full or associate membership except that he/she/it is not in the UK.

All members must be interested in furthering the work of First Person Plural (FPP). This does not mean that members have to be actively involved in FPP's work. It does mean that there are responsibilities, not only benefits, to membership. Thus, members must honestly support the objectives of FPP (see About Us leaflet); must not act intentionally to undermine the association's work or its reputation; and must behave appropriately and with due care and respect for self ('selves') & others when receiving or taking advantage of membership benefits.

Annual membership fee is £15.00. Any additional amount as a donation is always welcome. *Individuals from UK who cannot afford to pay the full membership fee may send what you can with an explanation of your circumstances. We recommend a minimum of £7.00 but will accept less in genuine cases of severe hardship..*
