AGM, Elections, Proxy Voting and getting access to Annual Report

The deadline to receive nominations for election onto the Board of Trustees has now passed.

A total of two nominations were received for the three available places for full members;. As **nominations received do not exceed available places**, a proposal (motion) will be made at the AGM to elect both the nominees unopposed.

If you are **not able to attend the AGM which is being held by Zoom** on 24th July, you can cast your vote on the motion **using a Proxy Voting Slip**. This can be accessed and downloaded at www.firstpersonplural.org.uk/agm2. You can then either return it by post **or** register your proxy vote by sending an email to admin@firstpersonplural.org.uk clearly indicating how you wish to vote. **Whether by post or email your proxy votes must be received by 21st July to be valid**.

If you have not already done so, **please register your AGM attendance or apologies by clicking on REGISTER** – you will then be given the option to book to attend or send your **apologies**. Alternatively, you can let us know by email whether or not you will be attending. The final deadline for booking to attend or send apologies is 21st July.

The Annual Report and Accounts which let our members know what First Person Plural's Trustees and volunteers have been doing during the past year will be presented at the AGM. Both of these documents will soon be available for download from www.firstpersonplural.org.uk/agm2. We encourage members to access them from there to help save postage, time etc. However, if you wish to receive a personal copy either by email or post you may request this at any time following the AGM.

We look forward to seeing many of you via Zoom at the AGM and Open Meeting on 24th July and to receiving proxy votes from those of you who cannot attend.

If you have registered to attend the link to the Zoom AGM meeting will be sent to you in an Eventbrite email on 22nd July and then again one hour before the meeting on 24th July.
